Opportunities for Volunteerism at Camp of Dreams

- 1. Teach a full 6-session course at our Community Days (every alternate Saturday for 12 weeks, Sept.-May)
- 2. Attend one or more Community Days and:
 - 1. Assist a teacher, either substantively (should be pre-arranged) or in class management (can be last minute)
 - 2. Staff the front desk to welcome students and families
 - 3. Arrange for snacks/water, and attend Community Day with the snacks to interact with the kids
 - 4. Assist Director with welcoming students and keeping the programming moving forward (aka, crowd management)
 - 5. Provide a Parent Workshop on a subject to be determined by you in conjunction with CoD staff
- 3. Summer opportunities include:
 - 1. Assisting Director with staff hiring (offering suggestions for young people, working with Director on job descriptions, interviews, etc)
 - 2. Assist Director with Junior Counselor interviews
 - 3. Come to camp for a day or two, meet the kids, interact
 - 4. Provide supplies or food (everything from a bowling party to tents and sleeping bags to an ice cream social)
 - 5. Arrange to teach a course, either as a 1-day "inter-session" or as part of a weekend activity
- 4. Opportunities at the Office include:
 - 1. Website updates (2 hours per month, can be done in our office or elsewhere)
 - 2. Monthly e-newsletter design (1 hour per week, in the office at least every other week)
 - 3. Prospect research; grant writing (1-20 hours per week, in the office at least once per week)
 - 4. Assistance with mailings as needed (October event, Winter ask letter, February event, pre-camp ask letter)
 - 5. Document management (1-20 hours per week, in the office)
 - 6. Weekly or bi-weekly bookkeeping (2-4 hours per week, in the office)
 - 7. Communication with CoD families (4 hours every other week, Wednesday afternoon/evening)
- 5. Fundraising Events:
 - 1. Help solicit for silent and live auction prizes throughout the City
 - 2. Serve on an event Benefit Committee
 - 3. Volunteer to staff an event (and receive free admission!)
